

## Villa Mira Monte Native Garden Management Plan

Plant Name	Management
2 - Coffee Berry Frangula californica	<b>Very low to low water need, irrigate once per month</b> , has very low water requirements, full sun to partial shade, slow growing, 6 to 15 feet tall, prune to maintain shape and space
3 - Coral Bells, Alumroot, Heuchera var	<b>Moderate to high water need, benefits from regular watering</b> , partial to full shade, benefits from regular watering, perennial herb, clean out winter damage stems and leaves to encourage new growth in early spring, divide crown every 3-4 years
4 – Deergrass, Muhlenbergia rigens	<b>Moderate to low water need, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun to partial shade, spikes and leaves to 4 feet tall, avoid pruning, thin out old brown growth to maintain shape
5 – Douglas Iris, Iris douglasioana	<b>Moderate to low water need, irrigate 2 times a month</b> , full sun, part to full shade, dead head when flower stalks dry,
6 – Great Valley Gumweed, Grindelia camporum	<b>Low to very low water needs, irrigate once a month</b> , tall erect flower stalks, prune in winter for control and clean up, full sun
7 – Woolly-leaf Manzanita, Archostaphylos tomentosa	<b>Very low water needs, irrigate once a month</b> , Low and spreading, prune in summer to maintain shape and space, full sun to partial shade.
8 – Mugwort, Artemesai douglasiana	<b>Low water need, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun to partial shade, cut back dead stems in early spring
9 – Pacific Madrone, Strawberry Tree, Arbutus menziesii	Currently the pacific madrone is a well-developed tree on site outside of the native garden area and well maintained.

11 – California Poppy, Eschscholzia californica	<b>Low water need, irrigate twice a month</b> , full sun, perennial herb but spreading by seeds, pull poppies coming up outside of its area as it can self-seed prolifically.
12 – Redflower buckwheat, Eriogonum grande var. rubescens	<b>Low to very low water needs, irrigate once a week</b> , Full sun, perennial herb, slow spreading
13 – Valley Oak, Coast live Oak, Quercus lobata,	Currently the Valley Oak, Coast Live Oak is a well maintained mature oak on site outside of the native garden area and is well maintained

14 – Wavy-leaf Soap Plant, Soap Root, Chlorealum pomeridianum	<b>Very low to no water once established, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun to partial shade, perennial herb, foliage disappear to partial shades in late summer and emerges in spring from below ground tuber/bulb..
15 – White Sage, Salvia apiana	<b>Very low water needs, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun, perennial shrub, prune long flower stems as needed during the summer and again in winter.
16 – California Wild grape, Vitis californica	<b>Very low water needs, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun, aggressive vine requires pruning through summer to keep it in check. In winter prune back stems to 3 nodes leaving short spurs. Consider fewer spurs the better, 5 - 7.
17 – Yarrow, Achillea millefolium	<b>Moderate water needs, water once a week</b> , full sun to partial or deep shade , perennial herb. Spreading horizontally via rhizomes, consider annual prune back to maintain space. Dead head flowers at the end of the season.

19 – Beaked Hazelnut, Corylus cornuta	<b>Low irrigation needs, irrigate once a month</b> , partial to deep shade ( it is an understory shrub), deciduous, it is a multi-stemmed shrub but can be trained into a small tree (will require sprout removal each year), prune to maintain proper size.
20 – Checker Lilly, Mission Bells, Fritillaria affinis	<b>Low irrigation needs, water 1 x per month</b> , Partial shade, perennial herb, bulbs require a moist spring and a dry dormancy in summer, allow flowers to dry and self-seed to create a fuller look. You can divide the bulbs in winter, prefer slightly acidic soil.
21 – Chia, Salvia columbariae	<b>Low water needs, irrigate twice a month</b> , annual herb, plants grow from seed each spring, pull volunteer seedlings to contain planting. Full sun, growth cycle is between 100-150 days, water 2x per month. May need to weed out Chia that are sprouting outside of its area.
22 – Black Elderberry – Sambucus nigra	<b>Low water needs, irrigate once a month</b> , full sun, tree/multi-stemmed shrub, will need winter and summer pruning to maintain a garden size tree.
23 – Narrow-leaf Milkweed, Asclepias fascicularis	<b>Low water needs, irrigate twice a month</b> , full sun, perennial herb, plant dies back in winter, multiplies via underground rhizomes, will need aggressive cut back to maintain space. Will self-seed, pull volunteer seedlings.
24 – Miner's Lettuce, Claytonia perfoliate	<b>High water need, requires moist soil, irrigate accordingly</b> , grows in partial to full shade, annual herb, grows new from seed each year. Allow plants to self-seed and dry out in late spring as temps rise.

25 – Sticky Monkeyflower, <i>Mimulus aurantiacus</i> var. <i>pubescens</i>	<b>Low water need once established, irrigate once a week</b> , perennial woody shrub, understory plant, pinch new growth in spring to maintain size, prune to maintain size.
26 – White Globe Lilly, Fairy lantern, <i>Calochortus albus</i>	<b>Low to very low water need, irrigate once a month</b> , partial to full sun, dies back once flowering is over, dead head as needed.
27 – Wild Lilac, <i>Ceanothus cuneatus</i> “Centennial”	<b>Low to very low water needs, irrigate once a month once established</b> , full sun to partial shade.
28 – Glassy Onion, <i>Allium hyalinum</i>	<b>Low water needs, water every 2 weeks</b> , spreads by bulblets, dig and spread bulbs to enhance planting. No water after flower dies, goes dormant in summer.
29 – California Wildrose, <i>Rosa californica</i>	<b>Low water needs, water every 2 weeks</b> , perennial shrub, prune to maintain shape, deciduous
30 – Yerba Buena (mint), <i>Clinopodium douglasii</i>	<b>Modertae to low water needs, irrigate once a week</b> , partial to full shade, perennial herb, prune to maintain space.
31 – Scarlet Buglar, <i>Penstemon centranthifolius</i>	<b>Low water need, irrigate every 2 weeks</b> , full sun to partial shade, perennial herb.
32 – California Buttercup, <i>Ranunculus californicus</i>	<b>Very low water need, no summer water needed as plant goes dormant</b> , full sun to partial shade, perennial herb, cut plant to the ground once dormant, self seeds so pull volunteers as needed to maintain space
Irrigation	1 per week – 1 Gallon Every 2 weeks – 2 Gallons Every 3 weeks – 3 to 5 Gallons Once a month – 5 gallons
